Field Visit Report

Date: 16th – 22nd February 2025

Location: Islamabad, Pakistan

1. Introduction

A Field Visit was held from 16th to 22nd February 2025,

2. Objectives of this workshop:

The objective of the field visit to Islamabad was to provide a first-hand experience on the implementation of the child to child (CtC) model in their schools.

3. Participants:

A total of 51 participants from the Maldives, Sri Lanka and Pakistan took part in the 6-day field visit to Islamabad. Each participating country was represented by 17 Participants delegates.

4. Facilitator:

The field visit was facilitated by the Cities for Children Team

5. Agenda and Activities:

- Day 1: Meeting with Cities for Children Team
- Day 2 Morning: Visit to Islamabad Model School
- Day 2 Afternoon: Visit to Murree
- Day 3, 4 & 5: Visit CtC implementing Schools
- Day 3 Afternoon: Visit to Museum
- Day 3 & 4: Workshop on Familiarization of CtC Materials
- Day 5: Closing Ceremony

During the 6-day visit, the participants 51 participants were grouped into 8 teams and visited 16 Schools in total. They observed the classrooms where Young Facilitators were helping Young Learners in a very interactive and play-based manner. Participants were able to meet with the school heads, class teachers and acquired knowledge on how they manage and handle the Child-to-Child session.
